Re: Request for Investigation of Abusive Treatment of Detained Individuals at Bossier and Pine Prairie Detention Centers

Dear Representatives Cummings and Thompson:

On August 29, 2019, a concerneodalition¹ reached out to Inspector General of the Department of HomelandSecurity ("DHS") and called for an investigation of violent and unlawful responses by Immigration andCustoms Enforcement ("ICE") nd its subcontractors at the Bossier Medium Security Facility in Plain Dealing, Louisiana, and at Pine Prairie ICE ProgeSsinte in Pine Prairie, Louisiana. To date, almost a month has passed with no response or acknowledgment of this letter, attached here.

ICE reported that "the number of detainees in facilities contracted by Immigration and Customs Enforcement in Louisina and Mississippi surged from just over 2,000 at the end of 2017 to more than 8,000 as of Juli 2019]." This is after Congress directed in February to decrease immigrant detention. Not only has ICE blatantly disregarded Congressional direction, but they also continue to mistreat and violate the due process right sprotected speed detained immigrants with impunity. In early August, it was reported to from numerous detained persons that ICE and its contractors also ssier and Pine Prairie, which is perated by for of the service of th

GeoGroup,respondedwith unlawful forceto detained immigrants peacefully protestingirthe indefinite and inhumane detentionarditions.

One of the 120 brave protestors at Pine PṛajrieH., recounts: [About fifty] officers dressed in headto-toe black riot gear with shields, helmets, vests, and masks began to exit the building. [...] Between the gas, the pepper spray, and the bullets, we wepter prannihilated[...] We had started shouting, asking for mercy. We asked them to stop shooting us, but Warden Ramos and the riot police continued in their attack against all of us. [...] I never expected an attack so brutal on a group of peaceful and electeless human being Many of these peaceful protestors were subsequently put in overcrowded solitary confinement cells, some for up to a month. At least one individual reported that he abandoned his asylum claim and requested to be deported, directly as a result of being held in prolonged solitary confinement when are immigrants who had come to this country fleeing violence, seeking refuge, and somehow we ended up here, hidden from public view in rural Louisiana. They do what they want to us here."

The lack of oversight of ICE and its contractors, and the impunity which they operates unacceptable. Without any response from the Office of the Inspectoral, it seems that ICE and DHS will again gounsanctioned or their heinous and illegalcts. We know through prior communication with you that the Oversight Committee the Committee on Homeland Security are interested in addressing ICE's abuse of power in the Deep South, and we appreciate your commitment. Now, we implore you to hold ICE and DHS accountable to conducting your own investigation into these troubling incidents as soon as possible and publicly releians the results
