

Loyal Garner, Jr., a black resident of Florien, Louisiana, was taken into custody on minor criminal charges by local law enforcement officials in Sabine County, Texas.

10. While in custody at the Sabine County Jail in Hemphill.

Texas, Garner was dragged from his cell and savagely beaten by defendants Ladner, Hyden, and Horton.

11. After he was beaten and severely injured, Garner was dragged back to his cell and left to suffer throughout the night of December 25 and the morning of December 26.


