NMMC—of which the West Point facility is a part—is identified as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit

entity that is subject to the requirements of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). The ACA contains several provisions that affect the way NMMC provides services to patients.

For example, the ACA requires hospitals to provide certain policies addressing financial assistance policies, as well as reasonable collection and billing practices, to the uninsured who come to the hospital. (See 26 CFR 1.1501(e)-4(c)(2)(ii)(C) of the regulations.)

Another key requirement is the provision of a "patient financial assistance policy," which must be "affordable" and "reasonably necessary," as provided by the "regulations." The PAP must detail the method for applying, as well as the amounts, applicable to the patient's medical bills. (See 26 CFR 1.1501(e)-4(c)(2)(i).)
